<u>W AC 392-172-124</u> <u>Definition and Eligibility Criteria for Health</u> Impaired

Students with health impairments are those who have limited strength, vitality or alertness, including a heightened alertness to environmental stimuli, that results in limited alertness with respect to the educational environment due to chronic or acute health problems, such as heart condition, rheumatic fever, nephritis, asthma, hemophilia, lead poisoning, leukemia, or diabetes, that adversely affect their educational performance and require specially designed instruction. All students being considered for eligibility for special education and any necessary related services under this category shall be evaluated in all areas of suspected disability and in accordance with the procedures in WAC 392-172-106 through 392-172-111.
