WAC 392-172-138 Definition and eligibility criteria for deaf.

Students who are deaf are those students who have a documented hearing impairment which is so severe that the student is impaired in processing linguistic information through hearing, with or without amplification that adversely affects educational performance **and** requires specially designed instruction.

All students being considered for eligibility for special eeucation and any necessary related services under this category shall be evaluated in all areas of suspected disability and in accordance with the procedures in WAC 392-172-106 through 392-172-111.
