The committee met with the Principal Evaluation Committee to draft summative descriptions for the 4-tier rating scale. Jon DeJong explained the task. Process:

- 1. Identify domains
- 2. Write a description statement of each tier including elements of the domains.
- 3. Pass to the left and underline what you think is important.
- 4. List words and phrases on the easel that are highlighted to then draft the description.

The committee agreed to the three domains suggested by Scott:

- 1. Content/knowledge
- 2. Pedagogical competence (instructional competence)
- 3. Professional Practice

## Tier 1: Unsatisfactory

The teacher does not understand or demonstrate the content knowledge, pedagogy/instruction, and/or professional practice necessary to improve student learning.
