 2. If a student has requested a prearranged absence and will not be here on Friday during make-up time, they must have approval in advance from the Principal, and then students will make arrangements with the teacher(s) to make up any missed exams
 3. Credit Completion Planning - Students who are not going to meet standard in their class may use this time to build a program of credit completion with their teacher. It is recommended that teachers require these students to report on Friday morning.
