

# Coffeyville Community College

## Career & Technical Education (CTE) Fact Sheet

- Senate Bill 155 provides funding for high school students to attend an approved CTE program at a community or technical college tuition free.
- School districts will be reimbursed for mileage to transport high school students to approved CTE programs by KSDE.
- KBOR will pay school districts a \$250 incentive award for students who complete an approved industry-recognized third-party certification upon completion of a high-demand CTE program/occupation.
- The student must successfully complete the certification within six (6) months of graduation from high school for the school district to receive the \$250 incentive award.
- School districts are required to pay one-half of the cost of approved industry-recognized certifications in an amount not to exceed \$250. School districts are responsible to pay for the first and second attempts to complete the certification. If a student does not pass the second attempt the school district is not responsible for paying for a third attempt.
- The high school student is responsible for payment of one-half of the approved industry-recognized certifications, unless the school district chooses to pay the full amount for certification.
- The high school student is responsible for payment of all program fees, books, and equipment or clothing required for participation in an approved CTE program, unless the school district chooses to pay for these costs.
- Students must reside in KS and attend a KS high school.
