



International Student Advance Deposit Policy

In order to ensure that applicants have the ability to finance their education in the US, Coffeyville Community College requires a deposit for international students. The deposit shall be equal to one (1) semester of full-time tuition, fees and housing, plus a deposit for the required insurance policy to assure the policy is maintained throughout the student's attendance.

The deposit will be held until the student completes an academic program, withdraws from the program, graduates, or transfers to another college. The deposit will be credited to the student's account at that time.

Deposit amounts for those on scholarship are determined on an individual basis according to what the scholarship covers.

Coffeyville Community College reserves the right to reduce the deposit amount with written documentation of a student's financial support by their government or other evidence of payment guarantee.

At least one-half of the advanced deposit must be made prior to the issuance of immigration documents. The remaining dollars must be paid no later than the student's arrival on campus. Payment may be made by check, money order or wire transfer. Please use the following guidelines when making advance deposit:
