To be considered for the program, you must do the following:

- Submit your official High School and/or College transcripts.
- Submit test scores such as ACT, Asset, or Compass.
(Not applicable if Intermediate Algebra or higher and Composition 1 have been successfully completed.)

- Be able to perform the essential physical requirements of the program. (carry 50+ lbs and accurately perform duties in harsh weather conditions).
- Be able to hold or obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) .

CHECKLIST

- Schedule a Campus visit call 620-252-7157
Fridays at 10am during the school year, Evenings and weekends by appointment
- Submit all transcripts (High school, College or Military)
- Submit Test Scores (COMPASS, ASSET, SAT or ACT). Acceptance to program depends on these scores. Placement Testing (COMPASS or ASSET) is available at CCC by appointment. Test taken at another college will require request to have scores sent to CCC.
- Sign and return Insurance Verification/Waiver & Indemnification Form before the start of classes.
- Sign and Return Conduct Agreement which is provided during your tour.
- Electronic Enrollment in courses begin in April. A first-come-first-serve method is used for filling the new class. Measurements for tool belt and will take place on these days as well.
- Submit proof of a physical exam. A sport physical or a D.O.T. physical is acceptable and must be within six months of first day of classes.
- Work Keys Exam available – Date To be announced and is optional.
- Order Boots by June to give time to break in.
- Order Tools as soon as possible as they will need to arrive before first day of class. Used tools are subject to **inspection** and **rejection**.
- Show up for first day of courses.
