Background and Process

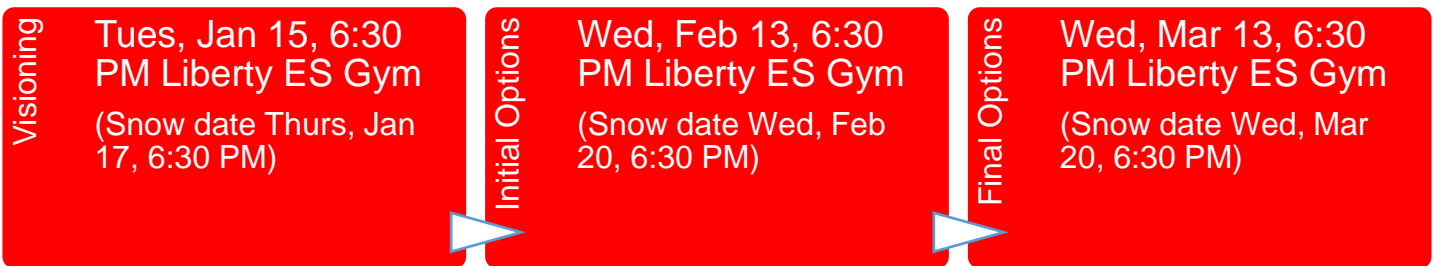
FCPS is beginning a feasibility study to determine the best way to modernize and expand Liberty Elementary School. The feasibility study will identify school renovation and space needs in order to develop conceptual options and cost estimates. FCPS will consider the existing building's physical condition, the building's ability to provide our current educational programs and the community's vision for the school.

During the feasibility study, staff will work with a consultant to consider several options:

- Renovate and expand the current building
- Replace the current building with a larger new building

This study is the first step in the process to modernize and expand Liberty Elementary School. The feasibility study will start in December 2018 and conclude in May 2019 and there will be opportunities for community members to participate throughout the study.
