

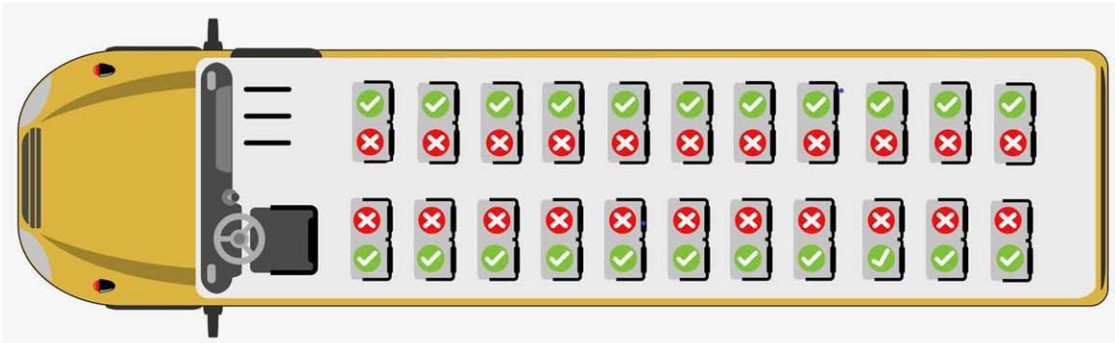


Transportation Guidelines

1. Parents/guardians are to screen their student's health daily for symptoms prior to school arrival which may include, but are not limited to:

a. New onset cough or shortness of breath
b. Temp 100.4 F or greater
c. Muscle/body aches
d. Fatigue
e. Sore Throat
f. Headache
g. Loss of Taste/Smell
h. Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea

2. Students must wear a mask if standing within six feet of others at bus stops and must wear masks on the bus.
3. No more than 22 students will ride a bus, with one student in each seat. Students in the same household may sit together, and this will still count toward the total.
 - Seats that need to remain vacant will be marked
 - Students will be assigned seats based on the route filling the seats from back to front
 - Visual cues will be posted to ensure social distancing



4. Whenever possible, windows may be open to the maximum extent possible when weather permits. Roof hatches and three windows on each side of the bus will be partially opened to increase airflow. Driver side window may be open, and fans will be utilized to increase the air flow.
5. Schools will be contacting parents regarding bus routes and pick-up/drop-off times.
6. For bus dismissal, students must remain seated until directed by the driver to exit the bus. Students may not congregate in the aisle to ensure compliance with social distancing protocols.
7. Adhere to all directives provided by the driver and follow all Transportation Bus Rules.
8. Buses and specialized equipment will be cleaned at the conclusion of each run. The focus of the cleaning will be high touch areas such as handrails, seats, window ledges, window controls, etc.
9. If a student tests positive for COVID-19, the bus will be taken out of service until a full cleaning and disinfecting is completed.
