1. Welcome!
 - a. Share the goal for the meeting: To examine additional data requested by the team and to set preliminary SAC goals for the district
2. Digging Deeper in the Data
 - a. EL/SPED/TEC Clusters: The committee did not find any patterns in this data. Some members hypothesized that the reason for the variance across the district was due to variance in instructional strategies as opposed to population.
 - b. ACCESS Data: Members studied the district ACCESS data.
 - c. MAP Proficiency Data: Sheri and Kim shared MAP's Proficiency reports and the "projected proficiency" for PARCC. Members discussed the need to have both GROWTH MAP goals and grade level PROFICIENCY MAP goals.
3. Goal Setting:
 - a. PARCC Goal: This was tabled until our next meeting.
 - b. MAP Growth Goal: Members decided to be more aggressive with our Reading goal since we have a new curriculum and have had 2 years of Reading PD. The recommended goal for 2018-2019 for Reading is 55%. Members were more conservative with the math goal. Next year will be an implementation year for math, and typically there is an "implementation dip" the first year. Members recommend keeping the Math goal the same as last year at 46%.
 - c. MAP Proficiency Goal: This was tabled until our next meeting for further discussion.
 - d. Low Variance Goal: This was tabled until our next meeting.
4. Looking ahead/Next steps:
 - a. Sheri and Kim will bring additional data to foster discussions around a proficiency goal.
 - b. Members will finish goal setting at our next meeting.
 - c. Members agreed to meet for 1.5 hours next time.
