Late registration for East Moline School District #37 students will take place on **August 1, 2, 6, and 8, 2018** this year. **You must go to the school to register your child. If your child is not registered by August 9, 2018, they cannot start the first day of school.**

Wells returning preschool students register August 3rd from 9am to 3pm at the school.

Wells new preschool students register August 7th from 11am to 7pm at the school. New students will be notified if they qualify to register.

Note: There are no registration fees this year. The only fees you may be required to pay at Glenview would be the following: calculator, physical education uniform, and yearbook. Families who live outside of busing routes may also choose to pay for busing at registration.

Only children who have reached their fifth birthday on or before September 1 of the current year are eligible for admission to kindergarten. Parents of **kindergarten children and children new to the District must bring a “certified” copy of the child’s birth certificate** to registration. Parents of students transferring to the East Moline School District will be asked to sign a release for all records, including health records. These will be requested from the school district previously attended. The complete name and address of the previous school attended should be brought to registration.

You will be required to show TWO proofs for Verification of Address to register your child for the 2018-2019 School Year. A few examples would be: Gas/electric bill and/or mortgage paperwork in parent or guardian’s name that states it is a current bill with that registration address provided. You will need to fill out a separate form for each child. Forms will be available at registration or you may download them from EMSD home page at <http://www.emsd37.org>. Additional forms will also be available at registration.

The ILLINOIS SCHOOL CODE requires that a child entering kindergarten or an Illinois school for the first time, and a child entering sixth grade, must present proof of a current physical examination and immunizations. The physical must be completed within the last year. **It cannot be over a year old.** This is required by the Illinois Department of Public Health before being admitted to school. Students transferring to the East Moline School District from another Illinois school must present proof that physical examination and immunizations were completed prior to first entering school or entering sixth grade. Please stop at the nurse’s table for verification.

All building secretaries, school nurses, and representatives from the transportation department will be on hand to provide services/information to the parents. Parents should also bring the child’s social security number and/or Medicaid number since it is requested on registration forms.
