**SENIOR DEBT CLEARANCE:**

After May 18<sup>th</sup> only cash, money order, cashier's check or credit card will be accepted for any payments.\*No personal checks.

**COMMENCEMENT TICKETS:**

Each senior will be given 5 tickets for commencement. Seniors will be able to **purchase up to 4** additional tickets from February 7 to February 28. These additional tickets will cost \$5.00 each and may be purchased in Student Activities at snack or lunch (CASH only). **If there are tickets remaining, tickets will be placed on sale the week of May 29<sup>th</sup>. If necessary we will have a drawing for an opportunity to purchase the remaining tickets. Only seniors may purchase tickets and with a student ID. All tickets will be distributed after rehearsal on 6/19.**
