AP Registration Process

- Students will register for all AP classes on Total Registration during the 1st week of school.
- Total Registration will email students the join codes for College Board courses.
- Students will add all courses on College Board.
 - Students will have access to AP quizzes and study guides in their online College Board courses.
- All exam payments must be made by November 1st.
- On Nov. 2nd any unpaid exams will be canceled.
- Registration completed after November 15th will incur a \$46 late fee

Cancelling Exams:

- Students can cancel any exams on Total Registration before Nov. 1st and receive a full refund.

Free & Reduced Lunch Status:

- Free and Reduced Lunch registrations will be waitlisted until the district rolls over to the new school year on Oct. 10th.

Accommodations (IEPs/504s):

- All forms for AP testing accommodations must be submitted by December 1st.

Benefits of the Free and Reduced Lunch Program

- Receive Free or Reduced Lunches; however, it isn't necessary to get lunches through this program
- AP Exams will only cost \$5 per test

The following items are covered:

- The registration fee for up to two SATs, with or without the SAT Essay
- The registration fee for up to two SAT Subject Test administrations (take up to 3 individual SAT Subject Tests on a single test day)
- Four limited-time score reports plus four to use at any time
- Four college application fee waivers
- A fee reduction for multiple-choice score verification or essay score verification
