South High Dress Code Reminder. This is a reminder that we have a dress code at South High and although it is warm you still need to follow the school dress code as stated in the TUSD Board Policy:

DRESS CODE (TUSD Board Policy 5132)

Students are expected to dress in a manner that is respectful and supportive of a positive learning environment, and while each student's individuality and expression of fashion is respected, not every fashionable outfit is appropriate for school.

1. *Clothes shall conceal underwear and cover midriff at all times. Halter-tops, strapless, backless and sheer / fishnet fabrics are prohibited. Tank tops must have a minimum of a 2" shoulder strap. Clothing that is revealing in nature is prohibited.*
2. *Shorts inseam length must be a minimum of two inches. Skirt length must meet shorts-length requirement.*
3. *Clothing, jewelry, bandanas, and personal items (backpacks, gym bags, water bottles, etc.) shall be free of any reference, text, or graphic which is vulgar, profane, gang-related, alcohol or drug-related, demeaning, or which advocate prejudice of race, ethnicity, sexual orientation or religious beliefs.*
4. *Hats and beanies are not allowed unless they display the South High logo and shall not be worn indoors unless medically / religiously required. South High hats and beanies may be purchased through various sports programs.*
5. *Students are expected to remove sweatshirt hoods, earbuds, and/or sunglasses before entering class.*
6. *Swimwear, pajamas, nightgowns, blankets, and oversized clothing are not appropriate school wear.*

The principal and staff may establish reasonable dress and grooming regulations for times when students are engaged in certain sports and/or classes and extracurricular / other special school activities.
