VISITOR / VOLUNTEER FAQs

Everyone coming into the Towers office and wanting to go onto campus during the school day for any reason will be required to provide a state issued ID.

If you provide us a scannable ID card such as a driver's license or passport card, you will only have to provide it the first time.

If your item is not scannable, such as a passport booklet, we will need to see it each and every time you come onto campus, as we have to enter the information in manually and the system will not save it.

If you qualify for a Volunteer ID badge by

- turning in a Volunteer Application
- turning in a negative TB test or screening dated within the past 4 years
 - having your state issued ID card scanned
- and getting your photo taken at the fall photo day or fall makeup photo day

you will be able to get signed in much quicker. We are having a chromebook set up so that volunteers with badges will be able to sign themselves in and out.

If you do NOT qualify for a Volunteer ID badge, you will need to get a printed label badge to wear each day you come onto campus.
