6th Grade Calle Mayor Math Math 6 is not your regular math class, by design Torrance Unified School District's Math 6 class is extremely rigorous and demanding. There is no need to rush students in math, the purpose of the middle school is build a solid foundation in math to set students up for success in high school. It is not a race to see how much math you can take in middle school, advancement in math in high school is guaranteed for ALL students regardless of the math class that they take in middle school. There is no college advantage to placing your child in advanced math in the middle school, advancement in middle school too early can actually damages the child's future in math. Look for the RED exclamation point with the pencil, these will be the areas that will require you to select a class.

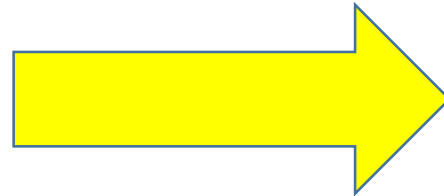
Click on the PENCIL and a screen will come up for you to make a selection from.

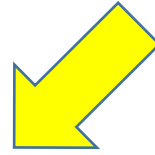


STEP 5

Click the edit button to request a course →



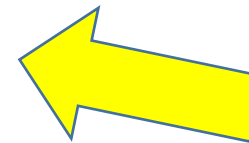
