- Days & Hours: Monday–Friday, 6:30am–6:00pm. Closed on some holidays.
- Distance Learning & Homework Support
- STEAM, Enrichment, Outdoor Recreation and Other Activities, designed to maintain physical distancing.
- Adherence to all COVID-19 Safety Protocols (10 kids max per room, face coverings, nightly cleaning & disinfecting, temperature checks, etc.)

Program Fees:

- **Weekly Rate:** \$205/per child

- We proudly accept CFC, DCFS and other 3rd Party Providers.
- Program fees are paid every two weeks (every-other Sunday) through a recurring bank draft or funds transfer, set up by the parent at the time of enrollment.
