<b>On Campus Classrooms</b> (classrooms, library, labs, testing center, gym)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Enter the room quietly</li> <li>2. Remove hats &amp; hoods at the door</li> <li>3. Follow classroom rules</li> <li>4. Stand quietly during flag salute</li> <li>5. Remain seated unless otherwise permitted</li> <li>6. Active listening when someone is talking (including Daily Bulletin)</li> <li>7. Use respectful language &amp; noise level (raise hand before speaking)</li> <li>8. Respect others &amp; their property (including school property)</li> <li>9. Maintain a positive attitude &amp; positive peer interaction (be a team player)</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be on time &amp; seated by tardy bell</li> <li>2. Use restroom prior to class (during snack &amp; lunch)</li> <li>3. Be organized &amp; prepared to learn (only bring necessary items from the locker; write classwork &amp; homework in planner)</li> <li>4. Remain on task &amp; complete assignments by due dates/times (including absent work)</li> <li>5. Strive for high quality work &amp; ask teacher for help when needed (advocate for yourself)</li> <li>6. Gum or food in class only with teacher permission</li> <li>7. Devices/electronics out only with teacher permission</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Respect others' personal space (keep hands/feet to yourself)</li> <li>2. Use materials appropriately (follow instructions)</li> <li>3. Wash your hands</li> <li>4. Follow JMS Dress Code</li> <li>5. Follow emergency procedures &amp; be mindful of others' safety</li> </ol>
<b>On Campus Indoors</b> (cafeteria/red cart, office, restrooms)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Enter and exit appropriately</li> <li>2. Remove hats &amp; hoods at the door</li> <li>3. Respect others &amp; their property (including school property)</li> <li>4. Use respectful language &amp; quiet voice ('please', 'thank you', etc)</li> <li>5. Wait for office staff to acknowledge you prior to politely asking for help</li> <li>6. Respect the privacy of students &amp; staff (ie. minimize conversations with students sitting in the office chairs; wait at the door; etc)</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Keep track of your belongings</li> <li>2. Stay &amp; eat in assigned areas</li> <li>3. Quietly stand in line (wait your turn)</li> <li>4. Take only what you need</li> <li>5. Clean up after yourself (place trash/recycle in correct bins)</li> <li>6. Go, Wash, Go in restrooms</li> <li>7. Alert staff when restrooms need extra cleaning</li> <li>8. Gum is not allowed</li> <li>9. Devices, cell phones &amp; headphones must be off &amp; out of sight</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>On Campus Outdoors</b> (quad, patio, lunch benches, lockers, stage, athletic field, hallways)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Use respectful language &amp; noise level</li> <li>2. Use quiet voices in hallways (be respectful of classes in session)</li> <li>3. Stand quietly during flag salute</li> <li>4. Quietly wait in lines</li> <li>5. Respect others &amp; their property (including school property)</li> <li>6. Maintain a positive attitude &amp; positive peer interaction (good sportsmanship; respect ballroom rules)</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remain in view of supervision</li> <li>2. Follow the rules of games</li> <li>3. Be a team player</li> <li>4. Include others in games &amp; activities</li> <li>5. Use PE approved sports equipment</li> <li>6. Clean up after yourself (place trash/recycle in correct bins)</li> <li>7. Gum is not allowed</li> <li>8. Devices, cell phones &amp; headphones must be off &amp; out of sight</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Respect others' personal space (keep hands/feet to yourself)</li> <li>2. Use your own locker (keep locker combo private)</li> <li>3. Retrieve items from your locker quickly &amp; move out of the way</li> <li>4. Walk in the hallway &amp; quad area (stay to the right in hallways)</li> <li>5. Keep outdoor areas clear of personal belongings</li> <li>6. Follow emergency procedures &amp; be mindful of others' safety</li> </ol>
<b>Off Campus</b> (front of school, parking lot, JMS neighborhood, community & beyond)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Exit campus by 3:05pm &amp; go straight to your destination</li> <li>2. Respect our neighbors &amp; their property</li> <li>3. Use respectful language &amp; noise level</li> <li>4. Clean up after yourself</li> <li>5. Be respectful on social media</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. School rules apply until you get home</li> <li>2. Play games/sports within campus grounds</li> <li>3. Keep track of your belongings</li> <li>4. Give back to your community through service</li> <li>5. Be responsible on social media</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be aware of your surroundings - remove headphones &amp; watch for traffic when crossing streets</li> <li>2. <b>Off Campus Learning</b> (distance & blended learning; homework; absent work)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Use <b>only appropriate language</b> on video meetings, chats, and comments/emails</li> <li>2. Use the <b>chat box &amp; comments for class related</b> questions or comments only</li> <li>3. Always THINK before posting (is it True, Helpful, Inspiring, Necessary, is it Kind?)</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Be <b>present and ready</b> to learn during each class "meeting" time</li> <li>2. Look for <b>teacher instructions</b> each day on the JMS Classwork/Homework doc, your TUSD email, &amp; Google Classroom/eTUSD</li> <li>3. <b>Stay organized</b> by using your planner or Google Calendar &amp; organizing your docs in Google Drive folders</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Use technology and devices as <b>intended</b> for school work</li> <li>2. <b>Keep</b> passwords and private <b>information private</b></li> <li>3. <b>Communicate</b> with teachers/counselors when you need support</li> </ol>
