







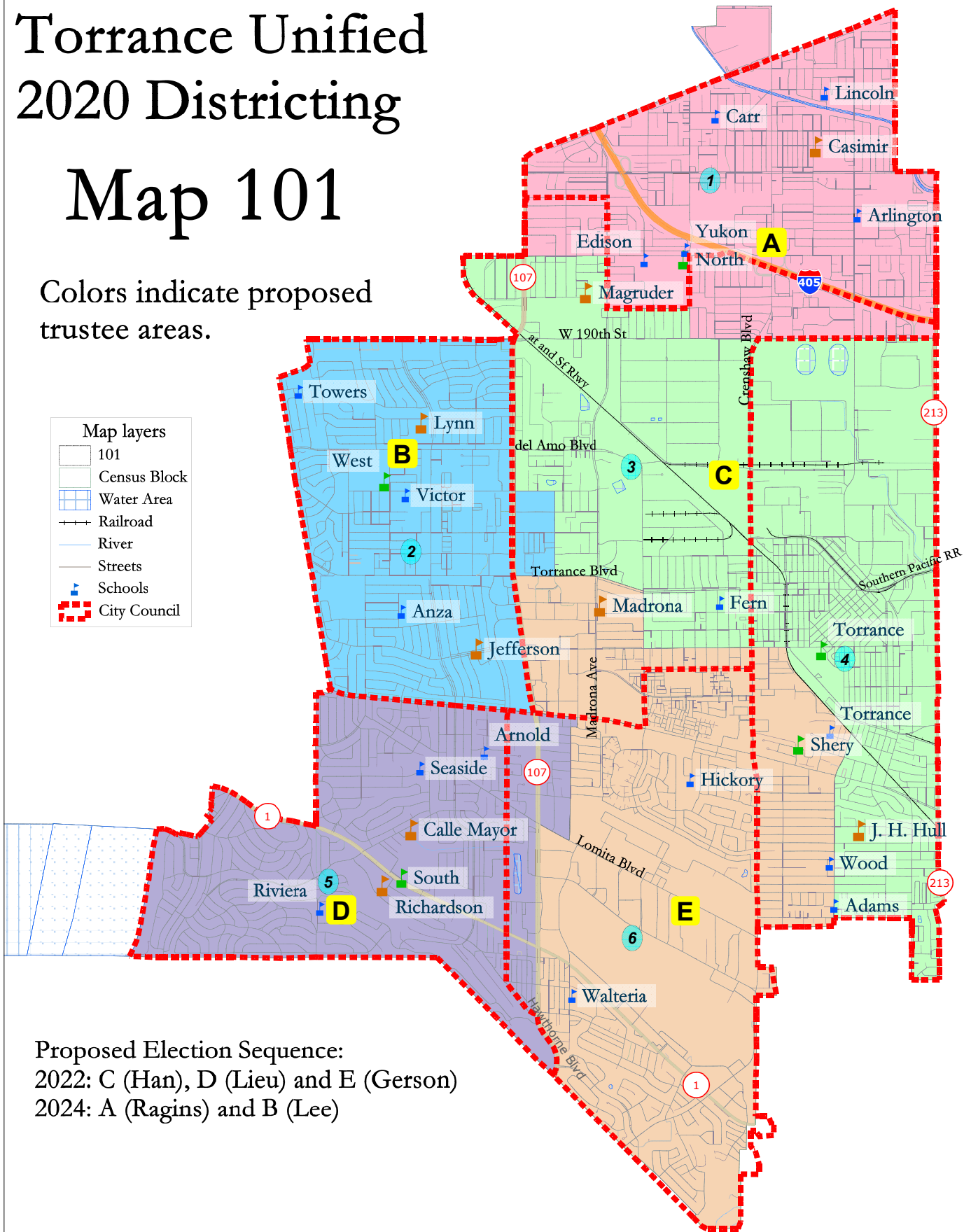


Torrance Unified 2020 Districting Map 101
