Timeline of Students Back at Calle Mayor

- October: Special Education, special category students safely back on campus. Almost 100 students and Staff.
- March: School Board allows for return to school, Red Tier.
- Grades 6-8th back on campus, 25 MAR 2021
 - 3/25 - 1st Day (“B” students)-ODD Periods
 - 3/26 - 1st Day (“A” students)-EVEN Periods

Sending out a Calendar/Bell Schedule on FRIDAY(19 MAR)

Dept. of Public Health (DPH) Guidance

- Must comply with all DPH requirements
- Current guidance is 6' apart in classroom
- 16-17 fit in standard classrooms
- Recommend “Stable Groups” as a best practice
- Calle: 720 students on an average day in-person
- Calle: @200 students in a cohort, in-person.
- Calle: Class size Academic @15-16 students, PE @ 32 (Outside)

Daily Health Screening, Mask, Protocols

- Required: Daily Health Screening(Students/Staff):
 - Check upon entry “Green Screen/Form”
 - Link: <https://c19.tusd.org/>
 - QR Code/Paper Copy(Calle Website)
 - Temp Checks at entry.
 - Two Facemasks required
 - Complete and follow all DPH protocols and pathways(Hand Washing, Social Distance, Contact Tracing, etc.)

COVID-19 Information and Resources



Daily Cleaning/Sanitizing

- Touch Point Cleaning throughout the day.
- Major Cleaning/Sanitizing will occur regularly in the evening
- Alcohol-based wipes will be available for additional cleaning
- Hand-sanitizer stations - in classrooms and around campus
- Signage Reminder:
 - “Wear masks, maintain social distancing and wash hands”

Additional Safety

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- Windows and doors open
 - Filtration in classrooms(hepa/bio-ionization)
 - Seating Charts & 6' Distance between student desks
 - Restroom limits: no more than 3 at a time.
 - Marks along the ground for spacing.
 - No locker use, backpacks will be allowed.

Distance v. Blended Learning

- During summer each family could opt into DL
- DL students will stay virtual entire school year
- BL students return to on-campus, in-person instruction.
- BL is divided into two cohorts(A and B), we will be sending a reminder to Parents on Friday, 19 MAR.
- Extremely tight on class size limits, safety is paramount.

Concurrent v. Asynchronous Learning

- Concurrent: In-Person and Virtual at the same time.
- Asynchronous: At home schoolwork assigned by the teacher, while the other group is in-person.
- Teachers will notify parents/students which model they will be using in their classes.

A/B/D Cohort Block Schedule(ABBA)

- “A” students attend Mon/Fri
- “B” students attend Tues/Thur
- Wednesday remains virtual for all A/B - late start (P. 1-6)
