U.S. CITIZENSHIP COURSES

INTRODUCTION TO CITIZENSHIP PREPARATION

IMPORTANT: Open to ESL Levels 3-6. This is not a full citizenship preparation course - students who want to obtain U.S. citizenship must take the ESL Citizenship course offered in Fall / Winter / Spring.

This class is for English learners who can answer simple questions and maintain short conversations in English. It focuses on N-400 application questions, parts of the required tests, and answering interview questions in English.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Do you want to know about the U.S. Citizenship process? In this class, you will:

- Learn what happens during the citizenship interview.
- Practice answering common interview questions.
- Practice listening, responding, and dictation to help with the N-400 interview.
- Review some topics of the 100 Civics questions.

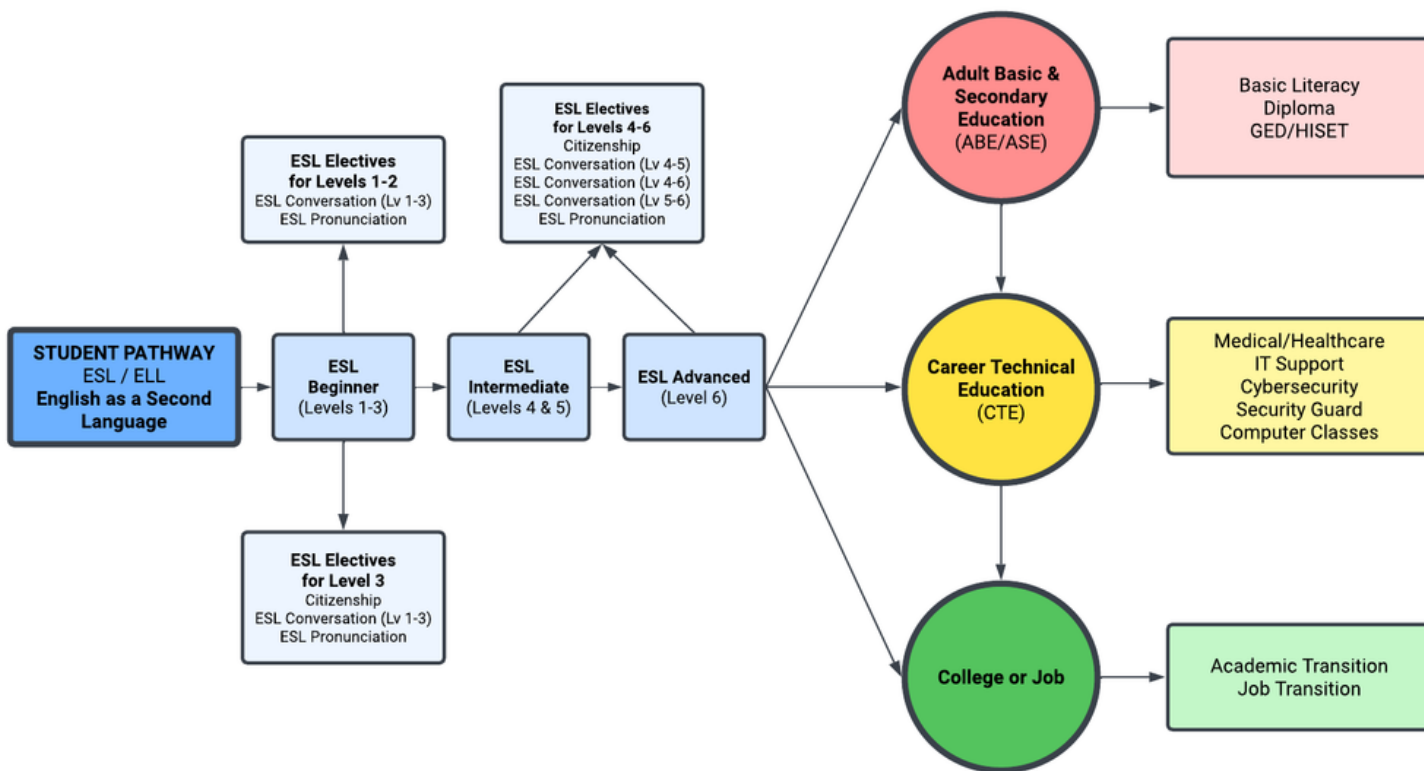
