PI Year 1 Schools: Right to Transfer -

All parents/guardians of students attending a school in Program Improvement (PI) have the right to request a transfer of their child(ren) to a Non-PI school with district-paid transportation. While our district does not provide bus transportation to the alternate school choices, <u>the district will pay for a monthly bus pass for your child(ren) (and you, for elementary students)</u>.

The District provides parents/guardians with the choice of two Non-PI schools during the open enrollment period each year. Eligible students will receive a letter during this period. Newly identified schools will send out notification within 30 days of being identified as a PI school.

In spring 2014 all California public schools participated in the Smarter Balanced field test for English-Language Arts and Mathematics. Because the field test did not produce individual student scores no API or AYP (for K-8 sites) was generated in 2014. Therefore, PI status is based on 2013 API/AYP scores. Below is a list of the schools in PI, as well as the two choice schools and their 2013 API (growth) score and AYP percent proficient ELA/Math:
