



## Reopening Guidance

- Parents commit to one of two learning options: a **Hybrid Learning Model** or a **Remote Learning Model**. This commitment is for at least the first half of the school year. Specific information on these models is listed below.
- All students will have 5 days of instruction with a District 126 Staff Member.
- Students and staff will be required to wear masks and maintain social distance while in school per current guidance provided.
- Whether in the hybrid or 100% remote model, the model for remote learning will be structured differently than what we experienced in the Spring of 2020.
- If there is a change in the current phase designation by the Governor, plans will be adjusted.
- District 126 will be offering before/after school care for parents choosing the Hybrid Model.

### Hybrid Learning Model

- Students attend two full attendance days each week and have three full school days of remote learning.
- Schedule A:**  
Monday/Thursday: In Person Instruction  
Tuesday/Weds./Friday: Remote Learning
- Schedule B:**  
Tuesday/Friday: In Person Instruction  
Monday/Weds./Thursday: Remote Learning
- Students will be required to attend “class” virtually on remote learning days through a structured model using a set schedule.
  - Parents will be offered a preference for Schedule A or B, however, this choice is not guaranteed.
  - An attempt will be made for siblings attending District 126 schools to be given the same hybrid learning schedule.
  - School bus service will be offered for students who qualify for transportation.

### Remote Learning Model

- 100% Virtual Instruction on all school days Monday-Friday
- Students will learn the same academic concepts as the students in the Hybrid Model.
- This model for remote learning will be structured differently than what we experienced in the Spring of 2020.
- Guidance for remote attendance indicates 5 hours of learning per school day to occur during regular school hours.
- Students will have a daily schedule. This will occur during regular school hours and include Zoom/Google Meets instructional classes.
- Students will be formally assessed and formally graded as they would if they were in the hybrid learning model.
