Cleaning and Disinfecting Products and Protocol

The school district will follow all recommendations from CDC, IDPH and ISBE for cleaning, sanitizing and disinfecting equipment, classrooms and buildings.

- The school district will utilize cleaning products that are known to combat COVID-19 and are approved by the EPA and are on the CDC approved list for safe use in school.
 - Force2 Disinfecting Wipes will be used throughout the buildings.
 - Halt, a Spartan disinfectant hospital one-step product, will be used at night in the electrostatic sprayers
 - Hand Sanitizers are alcohol-based and contain at least 60% ethanol (also referred to as ethyl alcohol).

Cordless electrostatic sprayers for quick and effective infection control will be utilized as recommended.

- Sprayers will be used when students are not present within school buildings.
- Sprayers reduce the amount of time required to disinfect an area.
- Sprayers will not replace other effective cleaning practices such as wiping down high touch surfaces.
- Halt, a Spartan disinfectant hospital one-step product, will be used at night in the electrostatic sprayers, which is EPA and CDC approved.

Classrooms, restrooms and frequently touched surfaces will be sanitized throughout the day.

- Frequently touched classroom surfaces and restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized during the school day using all approved EPA and CDC products.

All schools and the District Office will be disinfected nightly using only products that are EPA and CDC approved.
