

## **Asthma Inhalers at School**

**TO: Parent/Guardian(s) of Students needing asthma medications at school**

**Two options are available for the student who needs to use asthma medication at school.**

**Option #1:** Student will be allowed to carry his/her own medication and use it without supervision.

To utilize this option, please complete:

- Medication Authorization Form (completed and signed by the physician and parent/guardian) **OR** you may submit a current prescription label of the medication dated within one year
- Asthma history questionnaire (completed and signed by parent/guardian)
- Parent/guardian consent allowing student to self-administer
- Student agreement
- Return forms to your child's health office

**Option #2:** The student comes to the health office where the medication is kept and uses it under supervision.

To utilize this option, please complete:

- Medication Authorization form and Asthma Action Plan (completed and signed by physician and parent/guardian)
- Asthma history questionnaire (completed and signed by parent/guardian)
- Release of information (allows health office to clarify health provider's orders if needed)
- Return forms to your child's health office

***All medications brought to school must meet the requirements as outlined in the school district's medication administration policy.***
