Lunch Fee

Lunch is provided for children in grades 1-4 and All-Day Montessori (3-6 year old program). The required fee for this is \$730 per child for the school year. The required fee for the Three-Day All-Day Montessori is \$440 per child for the school year. Note, this fee reflects that lunch will **not** be served on 12 p.m. Early Dismissal days.

Piano and Violin Lessons

Available for students in grades K-12 for \$980 per semester. Music fees are payable for a full semester and are not refundable.

Tuition Payment Options

The Summit partners with Smart Tuition for the processing and collection of tuition and fees. Each family will be contacted via email with instructions for enrolling in Smart Tuition. The Summit understands that you have to make a variety of financial decisions when deciding how to pay for your child's education. Please contact the Business Office at grafton_r@summitcds.org or 513-871-4700 ext. 206, regarding any questions you have about the following Summit payment options. Each year families are required to pay the non-refundable \$1,000 tuition deposit for re-enrollment. Checks should be made payable to The Summit Country Day School.

Plan A – One payment by July 1, 2018. Pay the tuition and fees, less the \$1,000 tuition deposit, less discount (if applicable) by July 1, 2018. A \$25 Smart Tuition account fee per family will be assessed on the July 1, 2018 payment. Plan A families may choose to receive an invoice, pay by electronic funds transfer (EFT) or credit card. There is a 2.85% convenience fee assessed by Smart Tuition for all credit card payments.

Plan A discount of \$200 will only be applied to student accounts of full-time students who receive no tuition assistance including merit and/or endowed scholarships. Montessori students must be enrolled in five full-day programs without tuition assistance including endowed scholarships to be eligible for the \$200 discount.

Plan B – Two payments, July 15, 2018 and January 15, 2019. Pay the tuition and fees less the \$1,000 tuition deposit in two installments – 60% installment due July 15, 2018, 40% due January 15, 2019. A \$50 Smart Tuition account fee per family will be assessed on the July 15, 2018 payment. Plan B families may choose to receive an invoice, pay by electronic funds transfer (EFT) or credit card. There is a 2.85% convenience fee assessed by Smart Tuition for all credit card payments.

Plan C – 10 Monthly payments, June 15, 2018 through March 15, 2019. Pay the tuition and fees less the \$1,000 tuition deposit divided by 10 for the monthly payment. A \$50 Smart Tuition account fee per family will be assessed on the June 15, 2018 payment. Plan C families are required to pay by recurring electronic funds transfer (EFT) or credit card. There is a 2.85% convenience fee assessed by Smart Tuition for all credit card payments.

Tuition Affordability/Aspire Family Plan: The Summit has need-based tuition assistance for qualifying students age 3 to grade 12. The Aspire Family Plan provides assistance opportunities for families in kindergarten through grade 8.

Please note the following tuition assistance deadlines for the 2018-19 school year.

Current Summit Families: December 15, 2017

New Families: Priority deadline February 15, 2018. Tuition assistance applications will be accepted and considered on a rolling basis after February 15, 2018.

Families should begin the tuition assistance application process by submitting a Parent Financial Statement to The School & Student Services website at sss.nais.org/parents. Tuition Refund Plan

As a convenience to parents, The Summit makes available the Tuition Refund Plan. The cost of the plan is modest, (2.2% of the annual tuition fee for your student's grade/program), and it provides parents with the opportunity to minimize financial loss in the event of student withdrawal or dismissal. Details of the plan, including cost, are sent to parents with the Enrollment Contract. The plan pays benefits that provide substantial assistance in meeting the financial obligation of parents to the school.
