Board Briefs

At its March 19, 2015 meeting, the Skokie School District 68 Board of Education:

- Approved the Regular Session and Closed Session meeting minutes for February 19, 2015.
- Approved the resignation of one licensed faculty members and one classified staff members.
- Approved the appointment of three classified staff members.
- Approved the honorable dismissal of five classified staff members.
- Approved the Licensed Faculty Contracts for 2015-16.
- Approved the financial and activity fund reports for February 2015.
- Approved pay orders and expenditures for February 2015.
- Approved a five year lease with Midwest Transit Equipment, Inc. for four (4) New 2016 IC CE 71 passenger buses for a lease price of \$10,290 per bus per year and the purchase of two (2) 71 passenger 2010 Blue Bird buses that are at the end of their lease at a cost of \$32,500 per bus.
- Approved changes to the Employee Health Insurance Plan based upon recommendations from the District Insurance Committee in order to control cost.
- Heard a report on the District's Early Childhood Center Programs from Jac McBride, Director of Special Programs.
- Discussed potential revisions to Policy 1110 – Designation of Terms and Duties of Board, to allow a Board President to serve consecutive terms if voted to do so by a majority of Board members.
- Approved the administration's recommendation to award a contract to Heartland Business Systems to update the District's wireless infrastructure to prepare for the 2015-16 one-to-one technology initiative.
