At its July 15, 2014 meeting, the Skokie School District 68 Board of Education:

- Appointed two licensed faculty members and accepted the resignation of one licensed faculty member and one classified staff member
- Heard a report from Superintendent James Garwood on his entry plan to facilitate a smooth transition into the District
- Discussed the scheduling and potential content of a workshop on Board/Superintendent expectations and communications to be led by a representative of the Illinois Association of School Boards
- Heard a report from Technology Director Nancy Battaglia on the benefits of using an electronic board books format in order to increase efficiency, environmental friendliness, security, and transparency
- Heard a report from Assistant Superintendent for Business Beth Millard on potential alternative methods to provide elementary students with opportunities to participate in after-school clubs
