Board Briefs

At its March 18, 2014 meeting, the Skokie School District 68 Board of Education:

- Accepted the resignation of one administrator, appointed one licensed faculty member, granted personal absence leave to one licensed faculty member, accepted the resignation of two classified staff members, issued employment contracts for continued contractual status (tenure) to eight licensed faculty members, issued annual employment contracts to thirty-seven probationary, licensed faculty members, issued part-time annual contracts to ten part-time, licensed faculty members who are not eligible for tenure, and honorably dismissed one probationary psychologist and two classified staff members
- Appointed Lisa Schwartz as the new Assistant Superintendent for Instruction, effective July 1, 2014
- Approved a Resignation Agreement with one licensed faculty member
- Authorized contracts for the 2014 Summer Renovation project
- Heard a report from Assistant Superintendent for Instruction Laurie Heinz, along with K-5 Literacy Coach Stacey Woleben and selected students from grades 1-5, on the new K-5 Reading/Language Arts Curriculum
- Reviewed new Policies 4118 Suspension of Professional Personnel and 5131 Search and Seizure; and reviewed revisions to existing Policies 4117 Continued Employment and Termination of Professional Personnel, 4350 Drug and Alcohol Policy, 5112 Ages of Attendance, and 5113 Attendance, Attendance Records, and Excuses for Absences
- Adopted new Policy 6124 Title I Programs; and revised Policies 1317 Soliciting Funds from School Personnel,
 3265 Collection and Waiver of Student Fees, 3545 Pupil Transportation, 4111 Licensed Faculty Employment, and 4210 Classified Staff Employment
