Board Briefs

At its March 19, 2013 meeting, the Skokie School District 68 Board of Education:

- Granted family medical leave to one certified staff member, accepted the resignation of one certified staff member, and appointed three classified staff members.

Effective with the 2013-2014 school year, issued continued contractual employment contracts (tenure) to eleven certified staff members, retained thirty-six certified staff members on probationary employment status, issued annual part-time employment contracts to nine certified staff members, dismissed three full-time certified probationary staff members, three part-time certified staff members, and ten full-time classified staff members under an honorable reduction-in-force, and non-renewed one certified full-time probationary staff member.

- Heard a report from Niles Township Department for Special Education (NTDSE) Director Tarin Kendrick, NTDSE Program Supervisor and Psychologist Candace Hartranft, and District 68 Director of Special Services Jac McBride on the K-5 Special Education Program Audit.
