# Board Briefs

**At its April 17, 2012 meeting, the Skokie School District 68 Board of Education:**

- Accepted the resignation of three certified and two classified staff members, granted personal absence leave for the 2012-2013 school year to one certified staff member, granted family medical leave to one certified staff member, and issued probationary employment contracts to three certified staff members
- Heard a report from Assistant Superintendent for Instruction Laurie Heinz on the recommendations of the Gifted and Talented Learning Team
- Reviewed Policies: 1118 - *Board Communications*; 1150 - *Uniform Grievance Procedure*; 1241- *Convicted Child Sex Offender Law*; 1320 - *Public Access to Records*; 4350 - *Drug and Alcohol Policy*; 4353 - *Sexual Harassment*; and new policy 4354 - *Employee Use of Personal Technology and Communication with Technology*
- Reviewed the Resolution to Ratify the NTDSE Articles of Joint Agreement
- Ratified the Reciprocal Reporting Intergovernmental Agreement between the Skokie Police Department and the Skokie Public School Districts
- Appointed Eder, Casella & Company as the financial auditor for the district's 2011-2012 financial records
- Awarded a contract to MNJ Technologies for installation and maintenance of a wireless network at all four schools
- Awarded a contract to Henry Brothers Construction for summer renovation work at Highland Elementary School, Old Orchard Junior High, and the Early Childhood Center
