# **Board Briefs**

# At its March 18, 2008, meeting, the Skokie School District 68 Board of Education:

- Accepted the resignations of five certified and two classified staff members; issued employment contracts for continued contractual service (tenure) to thirteen certified staff members; issued annual employment contracts to forty-two full-time and seven part-time certified staff members who will remain on probationary status; adopted a resolution of non-reemployment of two full time and two part-time certified, probationary staff members; authorized a reduction-in-force of sixteen educational support positions
- Designated June 11, 2008 as the closing day of the 2007-2008 school calendar, with June 12, 13, and 16 declared as emergency attendance days
- Awarded contracts to Accu-Paving and Green-Up Landscaping for the Devonshire School playground renovation
- Heard a report from Superintendent Frances McTague on the TurnAround Schools: No Excuses University initiative proposed for the 2008-2009 school year
- Approved a five year lease agreement with Central States Bus Sales, Inc., for two 71 passenger buses and with Midwest Transit Equipment, Inc., for two 29 passenger buses
- Appointed Miller, Cooper & Co., Ltd., to conduct the annual audit of District financial records for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008
