Board Briefs

At its March 21, 2006, meeting, the Skokie School District 68 Board of Education:

- Heard comments from teachers and parents on direct communication with individual Board members
- Heard a report from Barbara Phillips, Assistant Superintendent for Instruction, on the gifted education program
- Discussed additional options to enhance Board member accessibility and communication with the school community
- Heard a report from Frances McTague, Superintendent, on the Strategic Planning initiative
- Accepted the resignation of three teachers, issued employment contracts beginning with the 2006-2007 school year to eleven teachers, issued annual notification of employment and salary to thirty-six teachers who remain on continued probationary status, issued part-time annual contracts for 2006-2007 to eight part-time teachers, adopted a resolution of non-reemployment of one first-year probationary teacher, two part-time teachers, and one temporary intern, and authorized the reduction in force of educational support personnel
- Appointed William F. Gurrie & Co., Ltd., to conduct an audit of the district's financial records for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006
- Adjusted student fees effective for the 2006-2007 school year
- Approved a contract with PowerSchool for the purchase and implementation of a new student software package
