You will be researching an event.

- You will be responsible for finding and citing your own sources.
(Remember all of the things we discussed about searching the internet and web evaluation!)
- kidrex.org would be a great place to start your search. Your chances of finding information that you will understand is much better here.
- Try your best to find a primary source, save it (or the link to it) to your ipad to use later in our presentation. Remember primary sources can come in the form of a photograph, interview, document, letter, telegram, etc. A primary source comes from someone who witnessed or experienced the event at the time the event happened.
- Questions you should be looking to find the answers to:
 - 1) What was this event? Imagine your audience knows nothing about this and give detail that will help them learn about it.
 - 2) Why did it happen? Give detail
 - 3) Where and when did the event take place? Give detail
 - 4) Who was involved? Give detail
 - 5) How has this event affected us today?
- I will put these questions at the top of your note pages. You will have to read, decide what it important, and where it belongs in your notes.
- Remember, you will be presenting this information to your class. The better your information, and the more YOU understand your research, the better your presentation will be!
