# • General Information

**Please read the handbook for detailed information.**

All students in grades 2-8 will receive a District owned iPad to use during the school year. All iPads will be returned at the end of the year.



## 2nd Grade

2nd Grade students will be assigned an iPad mini however, these iPad minis will stay at school and not go home with the students.

# • Receiving/Returning

Students will receive:

- iPad in case
- iPad charging block
- iPad charging cord

\*All of these items will need to be returned in good working condition at the end of the school year or if a student leaves the district. Failure to return the iPad will result in criminal charges being filed.

# • iPad Screen Care

- Only use a clean, soft cloth to clean the screen
- No chemical cleansers
- No writing, drawing, or stickers should be added to the iPad or case.

# • Carrying iPads

- iPads should always be in the protective case
- Never carry iPads with water bottles or other liquids
- Store iPad in a safe & secure location when not in use
- iPads should be closed and inside backpacks on busses

# • Apple ID

- Students will receive a district managed Apple ID this year which will be different from the Apple ID used last year.

# • School iPad Use

- iPad is to be used as a Learning Tool
- **Bring iPad to school fully charged each day**
- Inappropriate media may not be used as a wallpaper or background photo



# • Games

- Student may use educational game apps as directed by their teacher
- No web-based games during school day unless directed by their teacher

# • Home Wifi Access

- Students can use home wireless networks to connect to their iPads
- Parents are responsible for monitoring and managing student internet activity and iPad use at home

# • Saving Work

Students should use their school Google Drive and iCloud accounts to save and back-up work

# • Software

- Students can access and install apps from the “Self Service” app as directed by their teacher
- The district manages iPads and pushes out apps to students through JAMF Management software
- No additional apps may be installed

# • Updates

- Students are responsible for installing iPad updates when available
- We encourage students to install and run these updates at home if you have wireless access at home

# • Parent Responsibilities

- Talk to your student about values and standards your student should follow when using their iPad
- Parents will be responsible for monitoring student iPad and internet use at home

# • Student Responsibilities

- Use iPad in a responsible & ethical manner using good digital citizenship
- Keep passwords private
- Charge iPad each night
- Only install apps from Self Service app
- Keep iPad in District provided protective case
- Report any damage or concerns to a teacher as soon as possible

# • Repairs

- District will cover the cost of two damage claims per student during student's time in district. One damage claim per year will be covered.
- Damage includes cracked screens, broken buttons.



# • Loss or Theft

- Families are responsible for lost iPads (\$400).
- If iPad is vandalized or stolen, file a police report and contact the building principal immediately. Stolen iPads will be replaced by the district.
- Families are responsible for replacement of lost or broken charging blocks or cords ( \$40).
