When: Every Monday from 3:30 to 5:00 p.m.

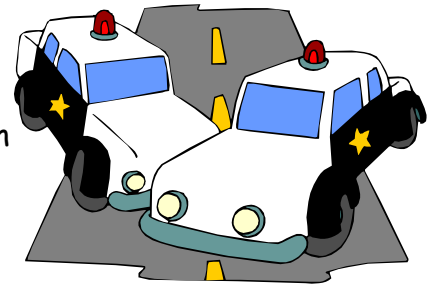
Starting April 10th through May 22nd
