What is it?

The Carnival is the PTO's winter fundraiser. There are games and prizes appropriate for children of all ages, face painting, temporary tattoos, balloon making, a cake walk, BINGO, and much more. We will also have a quiet room available.

Is there food?

There is a concession stand in the lunchroom that will have sandwiches, fruit, homemade bread, pizza, beverages and other snacks. There will also be popcorn and cotton candy available in the hallways. ***Game tickets are used to purchase all food, including the food at the concession stand.***

What is the Ticket of Choice?

The Ticket of Choice is located in the lunchroom. Local community members and businesses donate amazing prizes such as gift certificates to local restaurants, museum passes, baskets of goodies, and the like. Many teachers donate "lunch with a friend and the teacher" or similar fun experiences. Carnival-goers purchase raffle tickets, put a ticket into a bag that represents a prize, and win the prize if their ticket is pulled from the bag.

What is the Silent Auction?

The Silent Auction is located in the lunchroom and has great package deals such as weekend getaways, a signed Chicago Blackhawks jersey, professional sports tickets and the like. Carnival-goers can bid on items until the close of the auction at the end of the Carnival.
