- All media are encouraged, including but not limited to crayons, markers, colored pencils, charcoal, pastels, pen and ink, paints, collage or digital media, graphic design software, etc. All art created digitally must be printed and sized according to above guidelines.
- Each poster should be signed with the first and last name of the artist
- One entry per artist
