

COVID-19 and Travel Guidance

for District 97 Students and Staff

REPORT COVID-19 SYMPTOMS AND DIAGNOSIS

All District 97 students and staff who participate in hybrid learning must report the diagnosis of COVID-19 or if they are experiencing symptoms to their school nurse. Students and staff are required to certify that they are symptom-free each morning via CrisisGo.

AVOID TRAVEL

Travel increases the risk of exposure to the coronavirus for our students, staff and community. Postponing travel and staying home is the best way to protect yourself and others from COVID-19. If staff, students or families travel out of state for more than 24 hours, they should not report to school. The Cook County Department of Public Health recommends that residents avoid all non-essential activities, including school and work, for 14 days upon their return to suburban Cook County.

REMOTE LEARNING DURING QUARANTINE

If an individual student is required to quarantine, they will be provided the option to transition into remote instruction and, if they participate, those days will not be counted as absences. This includes students who: have traveled for more than 24 hours, have symptoms or diagnosis of COVID-19, or are part of a classroom that has been ordered to quarantine due to a positive test.
