- ✓ **ID PICKUP:** Pick up your ID for the school year!
- ✓ **PTO:** Brooks wear, lunch sign-up (depending on guidelines related to Covid-19), volunteer opportunities, and other PTO promotions
- ✓ **FEE TABLE (ONLINE ONLY):** Pay fees online, add \$\$ to your lunch account, purchase a gym uniform online if you'd like, update emergency contact information (We are not equipped to accept cash or checks during this event. Only online credit card payments will be accepted.)
- ✓ **BUS INFORMATION:** Pick-up your route info, if you live within busing boundaries
- ✓ **FORM DROP OFF:** Turn in physicals and medical forms
- ✓ **HALLWAY LOCKS:** Hallway lockers and PE lockers will not be assigned and used at least at the start of the school year to limit students' close proximity to one another. This will be re-evaluated each trimester.
- ✓ **PE UNIFORMS:** We will not be purchasing PE uniforms this year. If we determine that students can use the locker rooms for PE, we will ask students to wear or change into their own athletic wear.
- ✓ **TECHNOLOGY:** ALL 6th, 7th and 8th graders-Please bring your currently issued district device and associated charger (6th Graders IPAD/Charger and 7th /8th graders Chromebooks/Charger) to swap it for a new chromebook and charger. New students will be issued a chromebook at this time as well.
