

ATTENTION PARENTS OF STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES WHO ARE HOMESCHOOLED OR ATTEND

Children with disabilities who attend parochial schools or who are homeschooled may be entitled to services based on the proportionate share of Federal IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Act) money Lemont-Bromberek CSD 113A receives. Each year, representatives from the nonpublic schools in the District, as well as parents of students with disabilities or those for whom a disability is suspected who are parentally placed in nonpublic school or homeschools within the District's boundaries, are invited to provide input about how to spend these Federal dollars.
