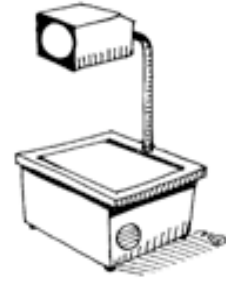

Session Descriptions



1. Stepping Stones to Data

Participants will gain an understanding of MAP assessment data and learn how to use the results to select instructional strategies to improve student learning. This session is for all third, fourth, and fifth grade classroom teachers, elementary special education teachers, ESL teachers, psychologists, math specialists, middle school math, reading/language arts, science, and social studies teachers, middle school foreign language teachers, middle school special education teachers, middle school learning center directors, middle school counselors and study skills teachers.

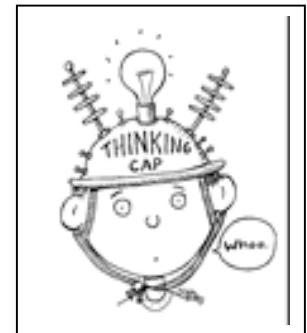
