- Cost \$90 if registered by September 11th
- Cost \$120 if registered after September 12th
- **REGISTRATION CLOSES Midnight September 18th** ***NO EXCEPTIONS!***
- Cost includes jersey, shorts, clinics, practices, league play, and tournament play.
 - 3rd, 5th, and 7th grades will receive a new jersey and shorts
 - 4th, 6th, and 8th grades are expected to use prior year's uniform, unless they did not play last season. Uniforms are available for purchase if needed.

Program Description

Basketball Clinics

- The WDP Varsity Basketball coaches, staff, and players will provide instruction in fundamentals and drills at WDP High School.
 - Girl's Clinics Dates: October 1st, 8th, 15th, and 22nd
 - **3rd-5th Grades: 6-7:15pm & 6th-8th Grades 7:20-8:35pm**
 - Boy's Clinics Dates: October 13th, 27th and November 3rd and 10th
 - **6th-8th Grades: 10:45am-12:15pm & 4th-5th Grades: 12:30pm-2pm 3rd Grade: 1pm-2:30pm**

League Play

- Fast Break teams will participate in the Bay Area Basketball League (BABL) Each league date consists of a team playing 3 games on a Saturday. 3rd graders play 2 games.
- League play runs Nov – Jan.
- Schedules are set by BABL schedulers. Coaches will communicate league play dates/times/location when schedules are in place.

Tournament Play

- Home Tournament: All grade levels will play in the West De Pere Home Tournaments.
- Away Tournaments: Grades 3th -8th are eligible to play in away tournaments. Players must participate in the clinics and league play in order to play in tournaments. Each grade level has a maximum number of tournaments that a team can participate in. Once teams are formed, coaches will communicate tournament information.

Parent Responsibilities

- Attend **MANDATORY** parent information meeting. Dates and times to communicate at a later date.
- Work a minimum of **FOUR HOURS** in concessions or other areas of need during home league and/or home tournament weekends for each child who participates in the Fast Break program.
