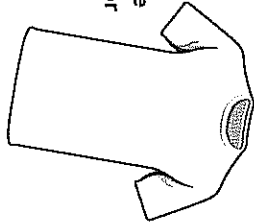

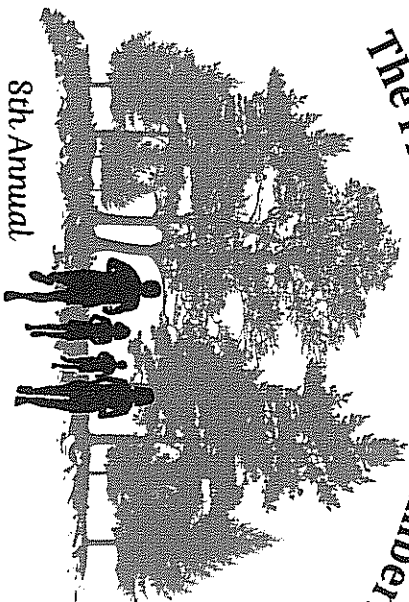

WAIVER OF NEGLIGENCE

Run Disclaimer: I know that the Fallen Timbers "Run for the Timbers" is a potentially hazardous event. The "Run for the Timbers" includes activities which include risks such as (but not limited to), falls, collisions with other participants, effects of weather, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, poor signage and/or planning of the route, and dangerous traffic and road conditions.

I agree, for myself and my heirs, to waive any claims arising out of the negligent acts of the organizers of this event. I hereby release, indemnify and hold harmless Fallen Timbers Environmental Center, its affiliates, directors, volunteers, and employees, all sponsoring businesses and organizations and their agents and employees and the Consortium of Schools for Environmental Education from any and all negligence arising out of my participation in the Run for the Timbers event.
