You compete against other teams that solve the same problem you solve, in your grade level. This activity requires TIME and COMMITMENT! Each team sets up its own schedule for practices. You are given a budget to purchase your supplies. You must work within that budget with no outside interference.

The Regional Competition will be on Saturday, March. 9th, 2019 and the State competition March 24th 2017.

YOU MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR THE REGIONAL COMPETITION DATE IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE

Teams typically meet one or two days per week for approximately 2-3 hours. In January & February, the teams typically meet on several Saturdays or Sundays to tackle bigger projects. (ex: costume making, painting, props, trips to the store, etc) Students are expected to make all practices and must be available on the above referenced dates.
