The School District of West De Pere is pleased to announce that Mr. Dennis Krueger has signed a contract to become the new Superintendent of Schools effective July 1, 2019. Mr. Krueger is currently the Superintendent for the School District of New London. He has served in that position since 2017 and from 2006 -2017 was the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Programs in the Howard-Suamico School District. His other educational experiences include serving Howard-Suamico Schools as a principal, Shiocton School District as a Superintendent and principal for eight years, an administrator in Neenah Joint School District, and teaching both at university and high school levels for a number of years.

Mr. Krueger's educational preparation includes a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from the University of Wisconsin - Milwaukee, further graduate studies in Educational Leadership, and a Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Wisconsin - Oshkosh.

He believes that a critical component of providing exceptional student experiences and maintaining high student achievement is the fostering of relationships throughout the district, both within the schools and in the community at large. Mr. Krueger encourages learner driven school environments. In doing so, he places a high value on collaboration, communication and creativity with the goal of accomplishing success for all students the district serves.

Mr. Krueger was selected from a group of 20 candidates that applied for the position. The interview process included interviews with two parent/staff/community advisory committee groups, interviews with the Board of Education, and a complete review of his credentials and contacts with references and several colleagues. Board members are pleased with his strategic thinking, strong leadership skills, community involvement, mentorship, and success in building a cohesive culture.
