

Continuing to Provide Personalized Education
Strategic Planning Session 2: Visioning a 21st Century School District
September 30, 2014

On Tuesday, September 30, fifty-two (52) Woodbury community members, Board of Education members, administration, teachers and staff, and students gathered to continue their work on developing a strategic plan. The second meeting was focused on conversation built around the question: *“If we were here together three years from now, and we were looking back on the past three years of work, what would we want to say we are proud of having accomplished in the Woodbury City Public Schools ... what have we accomplished?”*

Meeting participants worked in small groups, first recording individual thinking and then sharing their thinking with other small group members. Following group discussion, each group identified what points they agreed by consensus should be shared with the full group of meeting participants.

What follows is the summary and individual work of the small groups. Listed first are the consensus points made by each small group. The thinking of each individual then follows.
