

STATEMENT:

Please fund the School Funding Reform Act (SFRA) – the formula that calculates state aid to public schools – in a fair, equitable manner. If there is not enough money to fully fund the act, districts should receive state dollars equally in accordance to the proportion of funding available.

If the state currently funds SFRA at an overall level of 85%, then all districts should receive 85% of their SFRA determined allocation. It is not fair that Woodbury receives only 74% of its SFRA determined allocation while other districts are at or near full funding. Woodbury has unfairly been shorted many millions of dollars in state aid as a result of this inequitable distribution.

Again – we ask that you simply fund SFRA in a consistent, proportional basis across all school districts.
