We have outstanding AVID and AP programs!

Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) is middle through post-secondary college readiness system that is designed to increase school-wide learning and student performance. AVID focuses on the least served students in the academic middle -- students who are motivated and exhibit good citizenship but may not have benefited from gifted and talented programs. AVID students are enrolled in an AVID Elective Class where they improve their note-taking, organization, study-skills and collaborative technique. An AVID student is also enrolled in at least one Honors or Advanced Placement Class. AVID students are required to apply to one four-year college and are required to take the SAT during high school. They are expected to maintain a minimum of a "C" average in their core content academic areas.

Woodbury offers the following AP classes: Biology, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Chemistry, Computer Science Principles, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Music and Composition, Physics, Spanish Language, Statistics, Studio Art, U.S History, Psychology, and World History.

TRANSPORTATION NOTE TO PARENTS:

Transportation of choice students is not guaranteed. If a student is eligible for transportation (within 20 miles of the school) and the cost will exceed \$884, the parent/guardian will be given \$884 as aid in lieu of transportation and, in some cases, the option of receiving the transportation and paying the additional amount over \$884.
