Food Service Procedures

The Woodbury City Public School District wishes to continue to offer eligible students the meals that they would have received if school was not closed. The following is the food service plan:

- Woodbury School District will be offering breakfast and lunch to all eligible students.
 - All Woodbury students are eligible for a free breakfast.
 - Woodbury students that qualify for free and reduced lunches are eligible for a free lunch.
- Both breakfast and lunch will be a bagged “grab and go” meal.
- Only one breakfast and lunch choice will be available each day.
- Breakfasts may consist of cereal, muffins, and other nonperishable items.
- Lunches may consist of peanut butter and jelly Uncrustables, lunch meat with cheese sandwiches, fruit, milk, and other nonperishable items.
- All bagged meals can be picked up only at the Woodbury Junior/Senior High School and not the Elementary Schools.
- Pickup time will be from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- All breakfast and lunch bagged meals can only be picked up at this time.
- Pickup location will be in the back of the High School off of Wood Street. This pickup location may be subject to change. Park in the lower stadium lot and follow the signs to the “Meal Pick-Up” location outside the Gold Cafeteria.
- At pickup you will need to supply your name and the students’ names that you are picking the meal up for. You may pick up a meal for family members only.
- Please know that you will need to refrigerate these meals once the bagged meals arrive at home.
- All meals must be consumed at home and not at the school.
